1. Parking decal must be placed on the REAR windshield in the bottom corner on the driver's side.
2. Students may not enter the parking lot during the school day without written permission from the administration. The car is not a locker and should not be used in this manner.
3. The administration always has the right to search a car as deemed necessary.
4. Drivers should be courteous and cautious at all times; speed limit is **10 mph**.
5. Drivers and passengers must proceed to the building immediately upon exiting the car. For safety reasons, students who park at Dacula Park must use the crosswalk to cross Dacula Road. Failure to do so may result in the parking permit being revoked.
6. Loud mufflers, squealing tires, fast starts, or loud radios are not allowed.
7. Any reassignment of parking permits can only be done by the administration or their clerk. Permits are non-transferable. A student may not lend, give, or sell a parking permit to another student for any reason. Failure to comply may result in the loss of your parking privilege, and the parking fee will not be refunded.
8. A vehicle must occupy no more than one (1) space. Each decal is registered to one vehicle only.
9. A student must not use a vehicle in breaking other rules or policies.
10. Excessive tardies, AWOL's, excessive parking violations, failure to pay fines, and/or excessive absences, as well as failing grades could be cause for parking privileges to be revoked without refunding the parking fee.
11. **Efforts are made to ensure parking lot security; however Dacula High School and the Gwinnett County Public Schools assume no responsibility for damages, loss, or theft. IF CAR ACCIDENTS OCCUR ON CAMPUS, IT IS UP TO THE INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED TO SETTLE DAMAGES.**
12. When a student checks out, leaves for class at another school, or leaves for work study, they must leave campus immediately.
13. During the school day and during school sponsored activities, Dacula Park is considered a part of the Dacula High School campus. All school rules and regulations for both locations must be observed.

Violation of the rules will result in a ticket (fine) and other possible disciplinary action. The first ticket will cost \$25.00. Subsequent tickets (fines) will cost \$50.00. Tickets to Homecoming, Prom, Graduation and other school-sponsored events may be withheld until fines have been paid in full.

Your current driver's license, proof of insurance and Texting and Driving Pledge (found on the DHS website) are required in order to obtain a parking permit. At the time you received you decal from the Attendance Office, you will be required to initial and sign the Dacula High School Parking Regulations form and show a payment receipt from mypaymentplus.com.

I have read and understand the above stated rules and conditions. I understand it is my responsibility to follow the rules and conditions and should I violate any of said rules, I will receive a ticket (fine), disciplinary action, my vehicle is subject to being booted or towed, and will forfeit the privilege to park or drive on campus.
