## How much are tickets?

- February are \$65
- March will be \$70
- April 1<sup>st</sup> thru April 13<sup>th</sup> will be \$80
- No tickets will be sold after April 13<sup>th</sup>

## How many credits do I need to have in order to buy a ticket?

- Only students that have 11 or more credits at the beginning of second semester are considered Juniors or Seniors and may purchase a prom ticket. If you are in a Junior or Senior homeroom, you qualify to purchase tickets.

## What about Junior dues and Senior dues?

- Dacula High School does not have Junior dues anymore. Senior dues only deal with graduation, not prom.

## When and how can I purchase my prom ticket?

- All tickets will be purchased online using MyPaymentsPlus from February 1<sup>st</sup> to April 13<sup>th</sup>.

## Can I buy a ticket if I have library fines, parking tickets, or any other monetary obligation to Dacula High School?

- Yes, students may purchase a ticket, but their prom ticket will not be available to pick up until they have paid their fines. Please check the Portal to see if you have any fines before purchasing your tickets. Passes will be sent out before your pick up your tickets notifying you of any fines you may have.

## What if I bought a ticket and then decide not to go?

- Unfortunately, all prom tickets are **non-refundable**. This also includes date tickets.

## What is the “Prom Rules Form”?

- Dacula High School is requiring all students enrolled at Dacula High School to sign and complete a “Prom Rules Form” in order to get their actual tickets. The form requires a parent signature and outlines some of the basic rules about prom. If bringing a date, your date must also sign the Prom Rules Form. If your date is not currently a student at Dacula High School, you must also include a photocopy of their ID.

## Where can I get a “Prom Rules Form”?

- You can download and print one from the DHS website. Please make sure if your date is not currently a DHS student that you include a photocopy of their ID with the Prom Rules Form.

## Can you explain date tickets?

- Date tickets can be purchased by any Junior or Senior that has already purchased a ticket for themselves. Each eligible Junior or Senior is entitled to 1 date ticket. To purchase a date ticket, you **MUST** buy the ticket separate from your ticket on MyPaymentsPlus. This means you are making two separate transactions. The program will only allow you to buy one ticket at a time.

- All dates must sign the Prom Rules Form as well in order to get a ticket. Also, a photocopy of their ID must be made and turned in before April 13<sup>th</sup> (**if the date does not attend Dacula High School**). Dates must have completed at least one semester of high school and must be 20 years of age or younger.

#### **What can I wear to prom?**

- Prom is a formal event, so formal attire is required. No see-through clothing, lingerie/lingerie style clothing, or revealing attire. Length and cut of slits in dresses must be equal to, or longer than, four inches above the knee. No flip-flops or tennis shoes. You will not be admitted into the prom nor your tickets refunded if you fail to follow the dress code. Dress code enforcement is at the discretion of the school administration.

#### **What do I need to bring to prom?**

- All you need is your ticket and photo ID. **No student or date will be permitted without their official Prom 2018 ticket and photo ID.** The name on the back of your ticket must match the name on the photo ID or you will NOT be allowed into the dance.

#### **Once I get to prom, can I leave and come back?**

- No, once a student has entered they will not be permitted to leave and come back.

#### **When will I get my actual tickets?**

- Tickets can be picked up during all lunches on Thursday, April 19<sup>th</sup>. The student who bought the ticket on MyPaymentsPlus must be the one to pick them up. Any tickets not picked up will not be refunded.

#### **Is there anything else I need to know?**

- Students and/or guests found in possession or under the influence of drugs or alcohol are subject to severe disciplinary action, including a call to the parents for pick-up, suspension from school, and arrest by law enforcement officers. Possession includes any vehicles that are brought to the school's event location.
- Also, all GCPS rules as outlined in the student handbook will still apply at Prom 2018.
